**Free-Form Abstract Embroidery**

**9 hours: Friday, October 20 [3 hours] and Saturday, October 21 [6 hours]**

**Bio**

Embroidery has been a pleasurable hobby for many years and when she learned how to make works in an abstract manner without patterns she was completely hooked.

JoAnn states that this method is incredibly freeing and stimulating. Each student will be encouraged to explore individual ideas asking “what if” and put the answers into stitches. Just using two basic embroidery stitches the student will be able to create exciting works to give for gifts or display and enjoy themselves.

**Class Description**

The word “abstract” only means you can embroidery out of the lines. Do not let it intimidate you. The student will learn two basic embroidery stitches and how to utilize those stitches to generate ideas from pictures or, best of all, from one’s own mind. The students will also learn how to mount a finished project for display. A word or warning: this is an addictive craft!
