


Prismatic Star

Lucille has been quilting for many years; however, since 2007, her main focus has been on Judy Niemeyer foundation paper pieced quilts. In 2010, Judy introduced a Certified Instructor program and Lucille became one of the first 11 instructors in the program. She has taken 7 classes directly from Judy and has been to Montana two times for additional training on Judy's techniques. Her goal is for each student to enjoy foundation paper piecing the Judy Niemeyer way as much as she does. She looks forward to teaching students the techniques they need to make the beautiful Judy Niemeyer quilt.



Prismatic Star has been a very popular Judy Niemeyer pattern this year. You will learn techniques to complete this quilt. You may use

Judy Niemeyer Bali Pops fabric for the star points and a contrasting background color of your choice.

3 day class

General Class Supplies:

Fabric & Pattern - one Judy Niemeyer Bali Pop collection of 48 - 2 1/2" strips

Instructor will bring pattern to class - cost of pattern is \$29

Instructor will bring strip sets to class; however, she needs to know asap if you want to purchase strip sets from her - cost \$57

Black accent fabric - 1 1/8 yds (or color of your choice)

Background fabric - 2 yds (color of your choice, you may wait to purchase fabric after you have star done)

Cutting board (size to cut yardage)

6" x 24" ruler

6" x 12" ruler

Scissors, rotary cutter, seam ripper

Sewing machine with quarter inch foot and a snap on table that attaches

Needles - Sharps size 70

Paper Piecing Supplies:

- 18" add a quarter ruler
- Scotch tape
- UHU glue stick
- Flower pins
- Large ziplock bags (8)
- Purple Thang
- High quality thread
- Large paper clips
- Template plastic for fold template to make # x 18"
- Glue pen

If you have a 12" add a quarter ruler, you can use it; however, it is easier to use 18"

There is NO pre-work for this class. Teacher will be bringing the patterns and strip set (if ordered) for you to purchase in class.

The background fabric is 2 yards of fabric. You may purchase it before class; however, most students prefer to see the star points before deciding on a background color.
