

Arts & Crafts Sampler by Michele Hill 60" x 72" **Cheryl Keith**

Arts & Crafts Sampler is an appliqué quilt designed for an embroidery machine. **All embroidery machines will be provided** by Viking Sew 'N Quilt and/or Marietta Quilt 'N Sew set up for the class! The class is appropriate for beginners as well as advanced embroidery students. There are multiple hoopings for this quilt. There are nine blocks to make for the sample quilt shown.

Fabric Requirements:

You need 18" x 21" piece of fabric for background for each embroidery block. You may use a variety of fabrics for the frames, borders and accent pieces. For the quilt you need 2 ½ yards for the backgrounds. You may use fat quarters or larger for each of the flowers. You may use as many greens for the stems as you wish. In the sample, I used three different greens. Bring a yard of each. You will need 2 yards for each of the border fabrics if you do not want to piece them. Backing would require 3 ¾ yards and binding would need ½ yard.

Pattern required - \$15

There is a Kit(\$5) included with the class which will contain templates for each hooping for the nine flowers and detailed stitching instructions.

Supplies: In addition to standard sewing supplies

- Tread to coordinate with the fabric (use a good thread for embroidery such as Robison Anton Rayon 40)
- Small pair of double bent scissors for trimming around embroidery
- Stabilizer (I like Tear-Away)
- Cutting Mat, rotary cutter, ruler
- Bobbin thread wt. 60
