

## English Piecing Jane Godshall

This technique has been around for centuries. When first starting to use this technique some methods were frustrating and not producing the precision needed. Let's explore a precise, easy, economical approach to the long tried and true method while bringing it to the 21<sup>st</sup> century and maintaining the respect for the past.

From simple to elaborate quilts, this hand piecing method is a favorite. Just a few small pieces of fabric, templates needle and thread and you're off. We'll discover some tips and tricks to this old method and you will soon be hooked.

The kit provides mylar diamonds and triangles. The mylar is reusable and provides complete accuracy, tiny stitches and not sewing through paper pieces.  
P.S. This is the best take along project ever.

No machine required.

Kit Info: Tumbling Blocks and Stars **Kit \$45** Includes Mylar, Patterns, Instructions, Acrylic Cutting Templates, needles and thread will also be provided in class.

Supply List: Scissors, Rotary Cutter, mat and ruler. Needles and Thread supplied in class, but feel free to bring your own.

**FABRIC:** You will need a light, a medium and a dark fabric for your groupings of tumbling blocks. There are 7 groups. Each group requires a fat eighth of a light, medium and a dark. The stars and triangles require approximately 1 ½ yards of fabric should you want it to be all the same fabric. The full amount is not necessary to bring to class just for your information.
