

## **Hawaiian Appliqué**

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Aloha! In this class you will learn the history of Hawaiian appliqué, how to prepare your design and how to do needle turn appliqué. This is a great way to learn hand appliqué or to hone your skills. I hope you find Hawaiian appliqué as rewarding and enjoyable as I do.

#### **Supplies:**

Select a pattern from the book, Hawaiian Quilting by Elizabeth Root (order from Amazon or Dover Publishing, Inc. for around \$6)

One 24"x24" of a light fabric for the background, solid or tone on tone, 100% cotton

One 24"x24" of a dark fabric, solid or print that contrasts well with the background, 100% cotton

50 wt thread for basting your design

60 wt mettler thread to match the color of the appliqué go darker rather than lighter

#11 sharps needles

Small sharp scissors

Paper scissors

Thimble, if desired

Needle Threader (clover desk threader recommended)

Freezer paper

Pencil

Ott Light and extension cord
