

LeMoyne Star – Lap 52”x68” or Queen 92”x108” Donna Royson

Using a “Quilt in a Day” pattern, we will make three different blocks to create this beautiful star quilt. And guess what? There are NO “Y” seams! HOORAY!! All of the stars are made with ½ square triangle blocks. With just a little concentration and a lot of ½ square blocks, you will easily master this beautiful two color quilt. I will teach you a quick and easy method for making 8 – ½ square blocks at once and how to quickly trim them to perfect size! You will also learn simple methods to make your blocks lie flat once pressed.

Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Pattern – available from instructor \$9
- Optional 6 ½ “ Half Square Triangle Square Up Ruler (\$12 - available from instructor)
- 4 ½” x 12” or 6 ½”x 12” rule
- Basic Sewing supplies
- Marking pencil, pen or chalk
- Small cutting mat 10” or larger
- Ziploc bag – quart and gallon (for separating and storing units)

Light	2 yards	6yards
Dark	3 yards	8 yards
Backing	3 ½ yards	9 yards
