Nancy is a quilt artist, designer and educator of both piecing and longarm quilting. Nancy has been quilting for over 20 years. She was introduced into this wonderful world of fiber arts as a young mom. she is self taught in both piecing and longarm machine quilting. A few years ago, Nancy decided to try her hand at getting published. Her first quilt was Friendship Rings, in Fons and Porter's Scrappy Quilts, Fall 2011. That quilt made the cover of the magazine. And off she went! In the past few years, Nancy's quilt patterns have been published in a variety of magazines and books. Love of Quilting, Scrappy Quilts, Quilty, Quiltmaker, Quiltmaker's 100 Blocks, and Quilter's World magazines. Nancy recently appeared on PBS TV show Quilting Arts, demonstrating her Whimsical Appliqué and her Collage Quilting on the INNova. She has also very recently been a guest on Fons & Porter's tv show Love of Quilting. The show will be released in the summer of 2016.

Nancy will be teaching three one day classes:

Smokey Mountains Quilt

1 day class - Thursday

This is a fun quilt to make! Make it scrappy or control the colors. I take you step by step to keep this organized and easy.

Class Supplies:

Mountain fabric - 1 1/4 yards (if you choose to make this scrappy, then a 1/4 yard of each color or a layer cake will work)

Sky fabric - 1 1/2 yards

Border fabric - 3/4 yard

Binding - 1/2 yard

Nancy will send instructions for work to do before the class when we have the class list.

1 day class - Friday

This is one fun quilt! Scrap Scrappy or control the fabric colors. Students will need to focus on the "Ring" being the same color.

The quilt requires the following templates: Easy Angle, Tri Recs set, strip cutting ruler and a 9 1/2" square ruler or a 12 1/2" square ruler.



Whimsical Applique

1 day class - Saturday



Students will have fun with this new method! Adding additional colors to your applique designs adds visual impact and interest! You can control the colors by using the same color but change things by just changing the values. The fun part is using a variety of colors to add the whimsy! In class we will be using a die cutting system Accuquilt. Students are not required to purchase Accuquilt or bring one to class. If anyone wants to, please feel free to do so.

Students will need to bring a variety of strips in sizes 1", 1 1/4", 1 1/2", 1 3/4" and 2". Bring at least 10 of each strip size in a variety of colors!! As many colors as you can! (hint: not too many light backgrounds, try to bring brights from mediums to darks and jewel tones, fun prints add movement and visual interest)

2 yards of light weight fusible

2 yards of back ground fabric

1/2 yard for border
