

Modern Dresden Pillow

This pillow is made using shades of the one color to create a dimensional look. By just using some straight sewing and sub cutting you get this wonderful look, which looks much harder than it is. The finished project looks as if you did trapunto when you didn't. You can use the plates on a quilt or on a pillow. Your choice.

Supplies:

Sewing machine in good working order and basic sewing supplies

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Pattern purchased at class for \$6 (regular retail \$8.50)

15 degree ruler

18 inch pillow form (Will not need to bring to class)

Fabrics:

Outer Dresden $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of each fabric

Middle Dresden $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of each fabric

Center Dresden $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of each fabric

If all the lighter fabric is the same like the sample you will need $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of fabric.

Background and backing of pillow $1\frac{3}{4}$ yards

1 large button for the center ($\frac{3}{4}$ " or larger)

Batting 19" x19" inch square

There will be pre-class cutting that will be sent to you.
