Tree Bells 72" x 74" Sandra Jacobs

Tree Bells is by Coach House Designs. It is a simple pieced and appliquéd quilt. This is a great quilt to use up a lot of small scraps. I have used 4 to 5 fabrics for the bells but it looks great with a variety of fabrics. I also used a border print but that is not necessary. It looks good with other fabrics. I have used this as my Christmas Tree for the last couple of years. I jazzed it up with a big red bow and some Christmas tree lights. It is very easy to put up and take down.

Supplies:

2 7/8 yards of beige tone on tone – background and 1st border

7/8 yard red and white print – bells and 3rd border

½ yard green tone on tone – top of bells

1/4 yard red - bells

1/4 yard green – bells

1 ½ yards red tone on tone – ribbon, 2nd border, binding

1 1/4 yard multi-print on red – bells, 4th border

Other supplies:

Sewing machine that you know how to use and the manual, cord and foot pedal

Extension cord

Iron and Ironing Surface

Basic Sewing supplies, thread, scissors (fabric and paper) seam ripper, etc.

Fusible web -2 yards

Cutting mat, rulers, rotary cutter
