

Zig Zag (64" x 78")

First we will Zig and then we will Zag letting our jelly roll set the pace of our color placement. You can use a jelly roll or cut your own jelly roll from your stash. This is a great quilt to gift to a guy, a Graduate, or even a young couple. It may have a modern look but we will be using traditional straight line sewing and that's it.

Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order and basic sewing supplies
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
- Iron and ironing pad
- Pattern – Zig Zag by Mountainpeek Creations. It retails for \$9. Teacher will have them for \$6 but you will have to contact her via email or phone to reserve a copy. No extras will be available in class. Students are required to have their own copy.
- A few clips. You can use either binding clips or clothes pins about 6.

Fabric:

Jelly Roll – If cutting your own, you will need 39 strips.

Middle accent ½ yard

Accent fabric 1(left side) 1 yard

Accent fabric 2 (right side) 1 yard

Binding 5/8 yard

There will be pre-class cutting to do and these instructions will be sent to you prior to class.
