Class Description

This is a great project for someone that loves scrappy quilts. Got a stash that you need to cut into? This is the perfect project. We are using the pattern *Idyllic* by Cori Yoder as our starting point. Make as many blocks as you like. We will be constructing flying geese, flippy corners and half-square triangles. We will focus on speedy yet accurate sewing techniques. Beginners are welcome, as are experienced quilters with lots and lots of fabric!
