Bio

Teresa has taught English Paper Piecing for the American Quilters Society at their Quilt Week in Lancaster, Pennsylvania as well as across South Carolina for various guilds and clubs. In addition, Teresa has co-authored with Darlene Beltman a book, published by the American Quilters Society and published in 2016 entitled “*An English Paper Pieced Sampler*”. For this class, Teresa will bring several other English Paper Pieced projects to illustrate the variety of quilt making this technique supports.

Class Description

The Patchwork of the Crosses quilt was originally made by Lucy Boston in the 1950’s. This quilt has become popular among English Paper Piecers, because of its flexibility in design, ease in paper piecing and opportunities to create unique designs by fussy cutting.

This class will concentrate on making a single 12½” block and will discuss:

1. The art/history of English Paper Piecing;
2. Fabric selections for the project;
3. English Paper Piecing tools and techniques;
4. Fussy cutting; How to English Paper Piece;
5. Block assembly; and
6. Two options for finishing block, either appliqué to background or pieced edge.
