Bio

Donna's mother taught her to sew as a small child and she loves to share that knowledge with others as her mother shared with her. Donna has been teaching quilting and machine embroidery classes since 2001. Prior to her retirement in 2011, she worked 28 years for the State of South Carolina and a large amount of her work experience was spent teaching adults. One of the most important things she has learned from teaching, and also be a participant, is that just because one can quilt, does not mean she/he can teach others to quilt. In 2013 Donna received her Quilt in a Day© certification after attending four intense days of instruction with Eleanor Burns. Since that certification, she has taught over 45 classes in South and North Carolina. She has taught at QSC Pieceable Retreat, Myrtle Beach Quilt Party and several quilt guilds in South Carolina and quilt shops in both South Carolina and Georgia

Class Description

Join us in the kitchen as we cook up this lovely four block sampler quilt based on the book *Quilts from El's Kitchen* by Eleanor Burns! In this class you will learn how to make ½-square triangle blocks, flying geese blocks, sashings and cornerstones, appliqué, scalloped borders and bias binding – whew! So, put on your “Apron” (Block 1) and grab a “Cup of Coffee” (Block 2) as we learn what to do with “Broken Dishes” (Block 3) and “Squash Blossoms” (Block 4). The book *Quilts from El's Kitchen* is required and contains many more blocks for you to make at home, full color pictures for every step. Hardcover and spiral bound, plus recipes representing each block.
